

RULES




- Open to all New Port Richey Public Library cardholders.

 - Artwork may include computer generated, photographic, or paper submissions using pencils, pen, markers, paint, etc.
- Digital entries should be submitted with a resolution of 300 dpi or higher for printing purposes. The image / card should be formatted as a .jpg or .png with a size of 3.375" x 2.125".
 - Both horizontal and vertical designs will be considered.
- Art must be original, previously unpublished, and free of copyright restrictions. Please do not include your name in the artwork.
- Participants grant the New Port Richey Public Library all rights to the artwork and agree that all art may be displayed and/or reproduced without limitation or compensation.
 - Artwork may be altered to include Library branding.
 - Limit one (1) entry per person.
